



## 2021 Coastal Villages Region Fund Election Process

Coastal Villages Region Fund's Board of Directors is made up of democratically elected representatives from each of our 20 member communities. Board Members serve six-year terms, and elections take place every two years. All Board Members must be permanently domiciled residents of the communities, meaning they must have permanent residency and plan to remain a resident. Elections are run under a standardized democratic process designed to give fair voice to all residents of each community.

CVRF has seven seats up for elections in the following communities:

- Chefornek
- Chevak
- Goodnews Bay
- Mekoryuk
- Napakiak
- Nightmute
- Scammon Bay

CVRF has a stand election process where interested individuals who would like to run, please see the following CVRF staff in the following communities & fill out a candidate information form:

Interested residents have until **October 29, 2021** to fill out the Candidate Information Form so that CVRF staff could verify residency and financial standing (this means that the resident who wins must not owe CVRF any money).

On the **November 1, 2021**, CVRF staff will type up the submitted Candidate Information Forms on the ballot, which then will be brought to the voting place before general elections. Anyone who has not submitted a Candidate Information Form cannot be written on the ballot.
